Updated Standards released (version 3)

We released an updated version of the Open Banking Standards, extending Open Banking to credit cards, pre-paid cards and e-wallets in all currencies and offering a PSD2-compliant solution for account providers.

Customer Experience Guidelines published

These new guidelines set out how account providers and third party providers can create a consistent customer experience when implementing Open Banking.
